Applications are invited from Non-Hindi speaking Indians, Foreigners and NRI's for admission to the following Hindi Correspondence Courses.

3. **Certificate Course in Hindi (Preliminary Course/Middle Level) and Diploma Course in Hindi (Subsequent to Certificate Course/Secondary Level) through English/Tamil/ Malayalam/Bangla Mediums).**
4. **Advance Diploma Course in Hindi (Sr. Secondary Level) in Hindi Medium Only.**

(A) **ELIGIBILITY**

4. **Certificate Course in Hindi** – is for the beginners who do not have any/very little knowledge of Hindi and is open to all Indians whose mother tongue is not Hindi and Foreigners/Indian Nationals/Settlers residing abroad irrespective of their mother tongue. The minimum age limit for admission as on **01/07/2022** is **10 years**.
5. **Diploma Course in Hindi** – is for those who possess basic knowledge of Hindi and is open to all Indians whose mother tongue is not Hindi and Foreigners/Indians Nationals/Settlers residing abroad irrespective of their mother tongue. The minimum age limit for admission as on **01/07/2022** is **12 years**.
6. **Advance Diploma Course in Hindi** – is for those who have sufficient knowledge of Hindi and is open to all Indians whose mother tongue is not Hindi and Foreigners/Indians Nationals/Settlers residing abroad irrespective of their mother tongue. The minimum age limit for admission as on **01/07/2022** is **14 years**.
